
Meet Our 2022 Scholarship Winners!!

Hello Penn State Alumni Members and Friends,

This has been a year of change within the Penn State Alumni Association. Starting on July 1, the Alumni Association transitioned to a "one membership" model – meaning that your membership in the Alumni Association now includes membership in our local chapter. The Lawrence County Chapter is no longer able to collect dues and our communication grant may be reduced or gone completely within a couple years, which may affect publication of this newsletter in the future. But on the bright side, the Alumni Association will be providing our chapter with things like web hosting, a technology suite, and a new LionPerks(r) discount program available to all Alumni Association members.
