

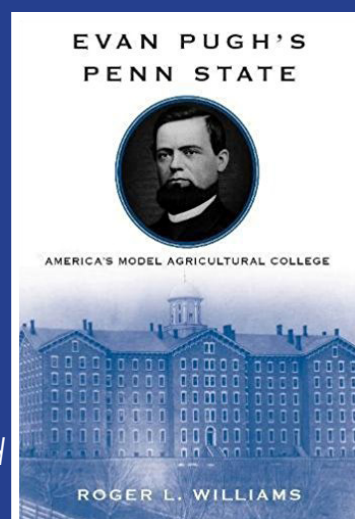
**"Evan Pugh's Penn State"
